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WEEK 4

Carrot Nose

Using the orange medium weight yarn.

Ch 16

R1: Dc in the 4th Ch from the hook. Dc in the next 4 Ch, Hdc in the next 3 Ch, Sc in the next 3 Ch, Slst in the last 2 Ch.

R2: Ch1, turn, Skip the first stitch, Slst in the next 2 stitches, Sc in the next 3 Stitches, Hdc in the next 4 Stitches. Dc in the next 2 Stitches, 4Dc in the last stitch and Slst to the bottom of the first Dc made.

Crochet Buttons

If you do not wish to use store bought buttons we can crochet some alternatives for our C2C Snowman Scarf pretty quickly with just a little bit of black or brown yarn.

Eye “Buttons”

Make 2

R1: Work 12Dc into a Magic Circle, Slst to the first Dc and Fasten off.

You can leave a tail to sew onto the scarf or use white yarn to sew onto the scarf.

Mouth “Buttons”

Make 4-6

R1: Work 9 Hdc into a Magic Circle, Slst to the first Hdc. Fasten off.

You can leave a tail to sew onto the scarf or use white yarn to sew onto the scarf.



Finishing

Sew on your 1 1/4 inch buttons as eyes, 3/4 buttons in a mouth shape and sew on your nose. I used white yarn to sew everything on so that it would not be noticeable on the backside of the scarf.

Sew on the carrot nose with white yarn. When sewing onto the scarf with white I make very small stitches on the front side of the carrot so when the stitches are pulled tight they are nearly invisible.

Don't forget to make and sew your pom pom to the top!
